Miami's Home Prices Are Plunging

Prices of homes in Miami fell by more than 11 percent last month, helped by declining interest in single-family properties and growing availability of condos in the market, according to Realtor.com.

The Newsweek article starts by referencing Realtor.com as the source for a purported 11% drop in prices of Miami homes in May.

Note the ambiguity at the very beginning: it is unclear if the 11% drop is on a city or county level, and if it is for condos or single family homes, or a combination of both. Having said that, this point is largely irrelevant in the context of this rebuttal, as neither SFH nor condos in the city of Miami experienced an 11% YOY pricing drop in May 2024.

Realtor.com has two articles with May 2024 data that reference this 11% drop.

The Realtor.com data referenced by Newsweek for their Miami-specific headline and the purported 11% drop actually aggregates Miami-Fort-Lauderdale-Pompano beach and is a measure of listing prices, not sales.

Analytics Miami cannot replicate this 11.2% drop in listing price data for the metro aggregate.

However, the focus and purpose of this report is to set the record straight on city of Miami pricing. Page 2 of this report charts the median sale price and the median list price of single family homes and condos in the city of Miami, through May 2024.

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
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From the Newsweek Article:

In May, condos saw their pricing plunge nearly 13 percent from a year ago compared to single-family properties whose prices dropped by 4.5 percent. Overall, the median home price has dropped 11.2 percent to \$439,000 in Miami, according to Realtor.com.


